The weekday missal and combined Sunday-and-weekday version will be published in June (£55.00 and £69.99 respectively).

Election of a New Pope Archbishop Mark has asked all the parishes of the diocese to hold a time of prayer at the start of the conclave, which commences on Wednesday 7th May. As such, on that evening, we shall host a holy hour followed by a votive Mass for the Election of a Pope. This will be in addition to the normally scheduled Mass on Wednesday Morning. Please do come along to pray for our church leadership as the cardinals select the new Vicar of Christ and successor to St Peter.
