New Archdiocese of Cardiff-Menevia As of Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> September, the Pope announced that the Archdiocese of Cardiff and the Diocese of Menevia are now unified into the new 'Archdiocese of Cardiff-Menevia'. This change took effect immediately, and so the whole of South Wales and Herefordshire is now one diocese. This will have significant and permanent effects on how we work together into the future. We will hear a Pastoral Letter from Archbishop Mark at all Masses this weekend. Please keep our new Archdiocese in your prayers at this time.

Mission Red Box Thank You and Appeal This weekend we welcome Fr Dermot Byrne to Aberystwyth to give a 'Red Box Appeal'.
