Advent The call of Advent is to get ready – not just for Christmas (although that's important!), but rather to learn how to live in a permanent state of readiness, of being alert: a preparedness for listening for the voice of the Lord speaking to our hearts. **Come, Lord Jesus!** And may he find us ready when he comes.

Immaculate Conception This beautiful feast of Mary's conception without sin, is celebrated on Monday 9th this year. The school will join us for 1.30pm Mass in Welsh Martyrs, during which we'll bless the new chapel of Our Lady. There will be Eucharistic Adoration beforehand from 12noon, known on this feast day as the 'Hour of Grace'.
