In lighting the third candle on our wreath, we reflect on the gift of joy: this Sunday we hear St Paul call us to 'rejoice in the Lord always: again I will say, rejoice' (Philippians 4:4). Pope Francis wrote in his document *Evangelii Gaudium: The Joy of the Gospel*, "With Christ, joy is constantly born anew... Joy adapts and changes, but it always endures, even as a flicker of light born of our personal certainty that, when everything is said and done, we are infinitely loved" (n.1,6). What might it look like *for you* to live inside the joyful realisation that the Saviour is coming to you this Christmas?
