The publishers have announced that daily Missals are now available for pre-order, with a prospective publication date of the end of April. There are two to choose from: the **Weekday Missal** has everything from Monday to Saturday, but nothing for Sunday, and costs £55.00. The **Daily Missal** has every day of the week, and costs £69.99. Please note that the 'Daily Missal' is about 1000 pages longer than the Weekday Missal, so it's quite a large book.
